The government registration fee for filing IPRs will be paid by the institute only if the applicant name is MLR Institute of Technology.

Note:

1. The scheme is applicable for the papers which are indexed in SCOPUS on or after 01/01/2023.

2. The incentives for research publications will be processed only after indexed in SCOPUS database under the account of MLR Institute of Technology.

3. The incentives will not be given separately for faculty members for filing IPRs.

4. The incentives for citation will be processed in June and December of every year (Duration: January – June and July - December).



Research Incentive Scheme - 2018

Objective:

The primary objective of the proposed incentive scheme is to motivate the faculty members of our college to undertake quality research, consultancy and other research related activities.

Scope of the Scheme:

This scheme covers all faculty members of all Departments of the MLR Institute of Technology. The scope of the scheme envisages in particular,

- to motivate faculty members to concentrate on research related activities in addition to the teaching so as to publish articles in reputed refereed international journals with impact factor.
- to pursue efforts to write books, monographs for publication by International and National publishers of repute.
- to evince interest among the members of faculty so that they take efforts to establish collaborative research projects with their counterparts in reputed Indian/Foreign Universities.
- to encourage the faculty to submit project proposals and secure funded research projects from various funding agencies in India and Abroad.
- to undertake consultancy projects sponsored by both the Government and Private Industrial and other organizations.
- to encourage creativity in the minds of faculty, so that they make original contributions by way of products, concepts etc. and obtain patents.

2	Greater than 50	After 50 points, in every set of three papers, minimum one paper must be in free journal and other two could be in paid journals.			

Note:

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- An incentive of Rs 5,000/- will be given for each point.

- Mentors need to specify two to three areas of research in which they need to guide their mentees. Out of first 50 points, 30 points should have papers belonging to those specified areas of research. Another 20 points of papers could be in any area.

- Distribution of RMS incentive amount will be in the ratio of 20:20:60 (Professional membership/activities: Mentor incentive: Mentee incentive).

- The mentor and his team cannot publish more than 3 papers in the same journal.

- If any journal is found to be of substandard quality by the Review Committee, that journal will be withdrawn for any incentive schemes viz. variable pay, reimbursement and RMS.

- The papers will not be ordered according to the date of publication for the purpose of calculation of points.

- This scheme is applicable from 1st January 2018 to 31st December 2018. To score your points, your published papers should be indexed in Scopus by the said date.

- The minimum points to be achieved by each mentor should be 50. It is mandatory for all the mentors and their team mentees to achieve the minimum target. The incentive will not be given to those who do not achieve the minimum of 50 points target. There is no maximum limit for publishing papers.

- Mentors are allowed to take authorship (first author) in only 20% of the total target specified.

- Inter disciplinary research can be done among the faculty members. Collaborative research can be done with other reputed Collaborators.

- Each Mentor can have a minimum of 5 and maximum of 15 members in a team (Mentee). It is mandatory for all the mentors and mentees to publish papers. The selection of mentees is based on their research areas and /or his interest. Further, the team must be balanced having equal distribution of PhDs/Professors/Asso. Prof./Asst. Prof. if possible.

11 Support for Antiplagiarism for PG Thesis and Research Papers.

All the authors are requested to check the plagiarism of their papers before submission to Journal or conference.

- Before submission of paper, the author should check for the similarity index of his/her paper. The plagiarism should be less than 20% only. If it is more than the said percentage, the authors should re-work on the paper and see that the percentage is between the above mentioned ranges. Once the value is met, the department co-ordinator and the mentor will sign on the hardcopy of the plagiarism report (i.e. generated before submission of the paper). That report has to be submitted during the time of reimbursement along with other files.

- Co-Ordinators for checking the Plagiarism have been nominated for each department. The coordinator should maintain a separate register/note book and should make entries. The coordinator should not delete the papers that are been checked from the Turnitin database. It is the responsibility of the department coordinator to check the plagiarism and make entry in the register. Further, the co-ordinator will not change the settings of the software.

- If the research papers are found to be Plagiarized, then the authors are entitled to return the reimbursement amount to the institute (if claimed) and the following paper shall not be included in the RMS/variable pay etc.

- The authors shall attach the plagiarism copy duly signed by the department coordinator (showing the similarity index value) during the time of reimbursement. mbbs

- The mentor will loose the mentorship amount if at any time plagiarism is found more than the specified value of 20%.

All the faculty members are encouraged to publish papers in good impact factor journals. As you all know, apart from the number of publications (count), even Citations, Impact Factor are also important. There should be visibility of your paper, and then only the researchers will be able to read your complete paper and then cite your paper in their references. Then you get a citation to your paper. Kindly do some research collaboration with reputed universities (India/Abroad) and publish papers. These changes come into effect from 01-01-2018.

A. Reimbursement of publication of papers in Paid Journals:

Condition 1:- One paper per author in the same paid journal only (as per previous research incentive circular Dt: 26-05-2017).

Condition 2:- As per the table given below (applicable for journal publications only),

* The Journal's list (Scopus/WOS) is been communicated to all of you. Kindly check the impact factor for the journal given in the list provided earlier.

B. Research Collaboration Incentive:

All the faculty members are encouraged to do collaborative research with Govt./ Private Institutions. Incentives will be given to the faculty members for carrying out collaborative research. The outcome should be a Scopus indexed publication. The incentives for this scheme are as follows.

* A faculty member of this institute should be in the authors list (irrespective of author number/position) of the research paper. The faculty member can apply for the above mentioned incentive once the published paper is indexed in Scopus database. This is applicable for all Govt./Private Institutions/Industries. In this scheme, incentive cannot be given for IARE and Vardhaman College faculty publications.

* The faculty member of MLR Institute of Technology publishing the research paper can have the co-authors from the same institute, Institute of Aeronautical Engineering and Vardhaman College of Engineering Institutes only. The faculty list of these 2 colleges has been circulated to

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all faculties. The faculty will not be eligible to apply for reimbursement if there are co-authors from other private engineering institutions of Telangana and Andhra Pradesh.

C. Research Mentoring Scheme - Updated

Incentives will be given to the Mentors based on the following points:

** All the faculty members should give the authorship/credit to students only in those papers where the actual research work is mainly done by the students. The guide should be the last author. Kindly encourage the students to publish papers in Scopus indexed journals or atleast Scopus indexed conference. Students expect their names to be there in the publication. This will be one of the parameter for the students who wish to pursue higher studies.

The mentors and the mentees are eligible to apply for RMS only if the papers are submitted to journals after 20th December 2016 only.

- The minimum points to be achieved by each mentor should be 50. It is mandatory for all the mentors and their team mentees to achieve the minimum target. The incentive will not be given to those who do not achieve the minimum of 50 points target. There is no maximum limit for publishing papers.

- Mentors are allowed to take authorship (first author) in only 20% of the total target specified. The mentors can be the last author in the remaining papers (80%). - Out of 100%, the percentage ratio for Scopus indexed (free, paid) journal to the Scopus indexed conference / Thomson Reuters Journal Papers is 60:40.

- Inter disciplinary research can be done among the faculty members. Collaborative research can be done with other reputed Collaborators.

- Each Mentor can have a minimum of 5 members in a team (Mentee). It is mandatory for all the mentors and mentees to publish papers in free journals.

D. Plagiarism Check

- To check the plagiarism, Turnitin software will be procured within next few weeks (by 15th August 2017). All the authors are requested to check the plagiarism of their papers before submission to Journal or conference.

- Before submission of paper, the author should check the plagiarism. The plagiarism should be between 20-30% only. If it is more than the said percentage, the authors should re-work on the paper and see that the percentage is between the above mentioned ranges. Once the value is met, the mentor will sign on the hardcopy of the plagiarism report. That report has to be submitted during the time of reimbursement along with other files.

E. Citations.

It is important to get citations to your published papers (Scopus indexed papers). You may cite your published paper also. But, more weightage is given apart from self-citations.

All the faculty members are requested to write the college affiliations properly. Kindly check the spelling (Author names, Department name, College name and address, Email ID etc) before submitting the papers to journals or conferences.

F. Indian Citation Index

All the faculty members are directed to publish papers in Indian Citation Index Papers also. The ICI Journals list has been communicated to all faculty members. Do not submit any papers to Google Scholar indexed journal.
